MOSAIC MINISTRIES IOTA FARMS

For two months migrant workers come to the Iota region to harvest and process the sweet potato crops. We had a great opportunity to minister to over 200 workers. We were very welcome by the workers.


NEW IBERIA CHURCH PLANT

We are still having ESL classes and many people received assistance with immigration information.

Merida, Yucatan Ministry

A group of 16 people from various congregations in Louisiana ventured to Merida, Yucatan to minister to pastors, their wives, youth groups and other churches in the area. From October 20 to the 25 the team led: a youth rally, a puppet show and carnival, a pastors conference, a pastors wives conference and a marriage seminar. On Sunday the team separated into various groups to preach and share testimonies at various churches. We received so much as we saw the spiritual hunger of the people of the Yucatan. New Iberia Church Plant:

3. Pray for the large groups of men who often live together crammed in small trailers.
4. Pray for the worker's families left behind in their countries of origin.
5. Pray for safe travel. Sometimes we travel 500 miles a week from ministry to ministry and visitation.
